- \$1,000 annual scholarship may be renewed up to three additional years.
- If qualified, renewal application must be completed annually during application period.
- Scholarships are limited to undergraduate college studies, technical or trade school programs.

### MINIMUM APPLICANT CRITERIA

- Must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.
- Must have a career goal in the crude oil and natural gas industry, or related energy field.
- Must be an OHIO resident attending, or planning to attend an accredited OHIO college, university, technical, or trade school.
- Must have and maintain a grade point average (G.P.A.) of 3.0 or higher.

### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of three-page application, signed and dated.
- Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, employer or other mentor figure. **Note:**Recommendations from family members are not acceptable
- An essay consisting of no less than 250 words, and no more than 500 words, describing
  personal and career goals, academic achievements, extracurricular activities,
  awards/recognitions, community service, work history, financial needs, and personal or
  family influences.
