When and where does the Red Cross need help?

- Most blood drives take place during the day. Monday - Friday, and occasionally on weekends.
- Blood drives are held throughout the Northern Ohio Region.
- You will provide your own transportation to the volunteer events that you choose.

How do I schedule?

- Sign up online and commit to the dates, time and location that best fit your schedule.
- Summer Youth Corps register for 10 volunteer shifts, be prepared to confirm your availability.
- We're counting on you to volunteer! Shift cancellations or no-shows will preclude you from participation in Summer Youth Corps.

How will I be trained?

- Dates/times will be sent by email to you.

You will register for a mandatory online training session.
