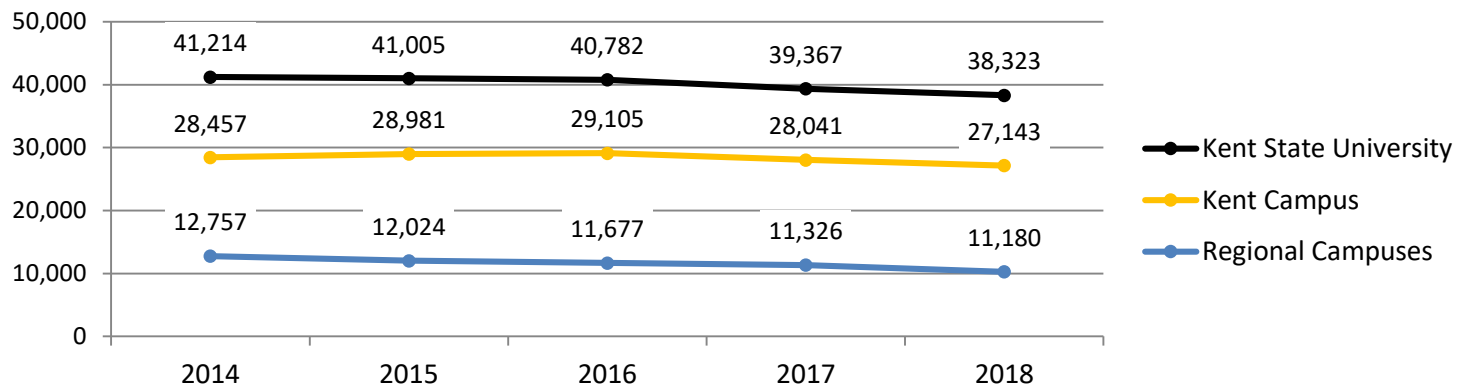
Student Enrollments
