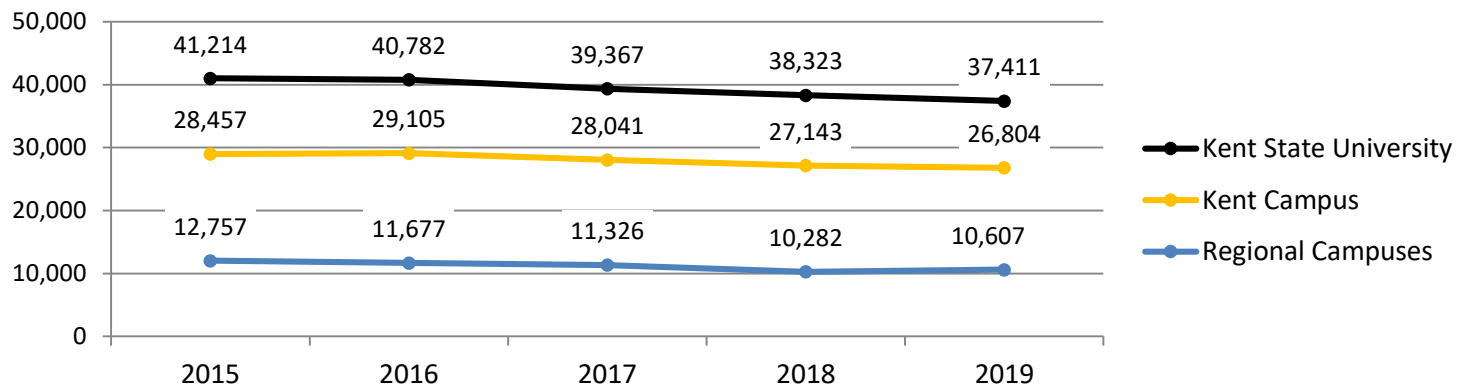
Student Enrollments
