Note: \$40 admission fee waived for high school graduates who earn College Credit Plus credit from any campus of Kent State University.
- Official high school transcript or GED certificate and scores
- ACT or SAT test scores are optional but recommended for course placement

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Applications are processed on a rolling basis. The best time to apply is by Thanksgiving of the senior year.
