## Drop-In Tutoring

We offer tutoring services in several subject areas to support the students and faculty on our campus. Our Tutoring Center is located in the library and is staffed by a professional math tutor and talented student tutors who can help students meet their academic goals. The weekly tutoring schedule is available online so that you can attend the tutoring session specific to your needs. Tutoring is free to all Ashtabula Campus students, and you do not need to make an appointment to attend a tutoring session. Walk ins are welcome!

## Supplemental Instruction

We are pleased to offer Supplemental Instruction (51) for our most demanding courses. In this model of academic support, students have the option to attend 51 sessions led by a student who has already taken the class from the faculty member and demonstrated academic excellence in the course. Ask your instructor if Supplemental Instruction is available for your course!

Supplemental Instruction (51) is a FREE series of group study sessions led by an SI leader. The 51 Leader is there to help make sure you are on the right track and to offer support and guidance. The 51 sessions meet two or three times a week outside of class to provide a supplement to the course lectures and to give students a chance to learn content in different ways. The sessions are designed to facilitate students working collaboratively to understand the course material in a relaxed environment and develop better study skills by discussing content, comparing notes, working together to predict test items, and sharing ideas for improving class material.
