



What is College Credit Plus (CCP)?

College Credit Plus was created by the Ohio Legislature to establish a way for qualifying Ohio students in grades 7-12 (including public, private, non-public or home schooled) to enroll at a college or university to earn both high school and college credit.

Admissions Requirements:

3.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average

AND

Meet Remediation Free Standards:

22 ACT Math Sub Score, 22 ACT Reading Sub Score, 18 ACT English Sub Score

- ☐ Meet with your school counselor to discuss your CCP opportunities
- ☐ Submit the “Letter of Intent to Participate” to your school by April 1
- ☐ Take the ACT or SAT
 - Must be completed prior to the application deadline; Writing portion is *not* required
 - Request your scores be sent to Kent State University (ACT Code is 3284)
 - ACT-Residual test can be taken at Kent State University’s Kent Campus or Stark Campus (fees apply)
- ☐ Apply for CCP online at <https://www.kent.edu/ccp/ccp-application>
- ☐ Complete and submit the College Credit Plus Permission Form
- ☐ Submit an official middle school or high school transcript to the Admissions Office on the Kent State University campus to which you are applying

- ☐ Follow instructions in your acceptance letter to confirm your admission
- ☐ Take any required placement assessments
- ☐ Complete your required Kent State University CCP Orientation **(on campus or online)**
 - Class registration will take place by appointment
 - Summer CCP Orientations on campus – May (dates TBA)
 - Fall CCP Orientations on campus – June, July or August (dates TBA)
- ☐ Share your schedule and any schedule changes with your school guidance counselor
- ☐ Work with your school administrators to obtain textbooks
- ☐ Notify Kent State University if you move or change schools or school districts
