• It is the student's responsibility to make a copy of this prospectus for themselves and their advisor, and submit the original copy to Graduate Student Services in 418 White Hall.
• A registration block will be put on a student's account if the Plan of Study has not been submitted to the Office of Graduate Student Services by the end of the second enrolled semester (including summer).
• The tentative course schedule is truly tentative. It is not guaranteed that courses will be offered during the semester, day, and time listed. Furthermore, courses are enrollment dependent.
• It is expected that you consult your Kent.edu e-mail to stay abreast of important program and university announcements. Also, refer to the CES program website located at http://www.kent.edu/ehhs/ldes/ces for downloadable documents and program updates.

Scheduling / Advising Notes:

- NOTE 1: It is advisable to take the following courses as soon as possible: Orientation and Ethics: Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling; Counseling Theories; Counseling Skills and Techniques; Group Work: Theory and Techniques; Multicultural Counseling, Introduction to Assessment in Counseling; and Psychosocial Aspects of Disability.
• NOTE 2: CES 57712— Orientation and Ethics: Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling consists of a comprehensive orientation to the program and profession. Students' initial orientation to the program occurred during the admissions interview and when receiving the admissions packet upon acceptance to the program. Students should take CES 57712—Orientation and Ethics: Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling in the first semester possible following acceptance.
• NOTE 3: You must register yourself into practicum as early as possible! If you do not get into a section, add your name to the electronic waitlist in Flashline. It is not guaranteed that individuals on the waitlist will get into their preferred section. During the Fall and Spring semesters, there are multiple sections of practica. Please consult your Flashline account for specific times and days. Also, there is only one section of Practicum I and Practicum II offered in the summer.
• NOTE 4: The total number of clinical hours accrued during CES 67492—Practicum I Clinical Mental Health Counseling and CES 69192—Practicum II Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling must total a minimum of 100 total hours, including a minimum of 40 hours of direct service to clients.
• NOTE 5: CES 69792—Internship Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling (600 clock hours including a minimum of 240 hours of direct service to clients), on advisement, taken at the end of one's program with no more than 6 credit hours of course work remaining. Courses listed on this prospectus as being a "Prerequisite to Internship" must be completed prior to starting CES 69792.
• NOTE 6: When planning internship, it is important to consider the amount of time it takes to obtain the needed minimum number of clock hours (e.g., 600 hours over two semesters) and the number of weeks available to complete internship.
• Note 7: When registering for ESPY, the subject is listed in the Educational Psychology program.
• Note 8: Students are only able to be enrolled in one field experience, including those with grades of "IP" (practicum or internship) per semester.
• IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING GRADES: In the Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling program, students must earn grades of a B Minus or better in all coursework. The Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, and Marriage & Family Therapist Board, will not accept grades lower than a B Minus. Therefore, if students earn a "C+" or lower in a course, they would have to repeat this course. It is also important to note that pass/fail (or "S" / "U") courses follow the policy that a grade of "S" or "Pass" is comparable to a "B Minus" or better. Please consult individual course syllabi for further grading policies.
• IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING DIVERSITY: The Counselor Education and Supervision program at Kent State University has diversity as a core value and diversity is integrated throughout the curriculum. As a student in the program, you will be expected to work with and affirm fellow students and clients who may be sexual minorities, who are of different races, ethnicities and religions, and who come from varying socio-economic statuses. The experience will challenge you, and you will need to be open to new ways of encountering people. The program faculty, staff and supervisors will be there for support in this journey.
