Courses that are equivalent to 1X000 or 2X000 are not directly equivalent to any courses at Kent State University; however, these courses can fulfill general elective credit that may be required. Once a student has been accepted to Kent State University, they may set up an advising appointment in their college office and supply their academic advisor with a syllabus for faculty review. If the course is approved as an equivalent, an adjustment will be made to the student's degree audit.
