* One additional course taken from the Kent Core Social Sciences (KSS) courses in the following Arts and Sciences disciplines: Anthropology (ANTH), Geography (GEOG), Criminology and Justice Studies (CRIM), Peace and Conflict Studies (PACS), Political Science (POL), Psychology (PSYC) or Sociology (SOC). **The course may not be from the student's major.** ANTH 18210 (KSS, DIVG) may fulfill this requirement.

** Minimum one course must be selected from the Humanities in Arts and Sciences area (KHUM), and minimum one course must be selected from the Fine Arts area (KFA).

*** Completion of the OT36 will satisfy the entire set of Kent Core requirements. Students who complete the OT36 may complete general electives in place of the Kent Core Additional courses.

**** One additional course taken from the Kent Core Basic Sciences (KBS) courses in the following Arts and Sciences disciplines: Anthropology (ANTH), Biological Sciences (BSCI), Chemistry (CHEM), Geography (GEOG), Geology (GEOL) or Physics (PHY). **The course may not be from the student's major.**

This Transfer Pathway completes the Associate of Arts degree, which must total at least 60 semester credits and includes 36 credits of the Ohio Transfer 36 (OT36), which are approved Tri-C general education requirements. OT36 details can be found at <https://www.ohiohighered.org/Ohio-Transfer-36>.

Requirements to graduate with the BA degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 120 credit hours, 42 upper-division credit hours of coursework, a minimum 2.00 major GPA and minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade.
