UHS ADD/ADHD Policy

- Prior to prescribing ADD medications, UHS physicians require diagnostic testing within the past 3 years

Testing available at UHS or KSU Psychology Clinic

- Students with ADD/ADHD are encouraged to register with SAS www.kent.edu/sas
- UHS Pharmacy **does not stock** stimulant medications

Health Information Privacy

- For students over 18 years of age, we **cannot** share health information without permission
 - even if they are covered under your insurance.
 - *A signed release for educational records (FERPA) does NOT include medical records (HIPAA)*
- Under 18 years of age, we will contact parent for permission to treat (with certain exceptions).
