^{**}All students must satisfy the diversity requirement, consisting of one course addressing domestic (U.S.) issues and one course addressing global issues. At least one course must come from the OT36 /Kent Core. Please consult the Transfer Credit Guide.

^{***} Must choose a course designated as a WIC as one of the Applied Business Electives. Must earn a C or better.

Please be aware of Kent State University's residence policy, which may be affected by the number of credits transferred, which can be found in the Kent State University Catalog.

The following courses can also be taken at EGCC:

- MGT 208 Human Resources Management will transfer to Kent State as BMRT 31006 Human Resource Management.
- General electives any college level course not already completed.
- Up to 86 credits may be transferred into the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Applied Business degree from EGCC.

Requirements to graduate with the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Applied Business degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 120 credit hours, 39 upper-division credit hours of coursework, a minimum 2.0 major GPA and minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade. More specific graduation requirement information can be found in the Academic Policies section of the Kent State University Catalog (www.kent.edu/catalog).
