- Up to 86 credits may be transferred into the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Applied Business degree from EGCC.

Requirements to graduate with the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Applied Business degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 120 credits hours, 39 upper-division credits hours of coursework, a minimum 2.0 major GPA and minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade. 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It is recommended that students intending to pursue the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Applied Business through Kent State University consult with academic advisors at both Eastern Gateway Community College and Kent State University.

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
