**Scheduling / Advising Notes:**

- Please see the relevant information on the School Counseling Program or Clinical Mental Health Program Prospectus or Plan of Study. Please review this information with your assigned advisor.
- To complete the Ed.S. in Counseling, 30 credit hours are needed beyond counseling master's degree.
- Courses used to fulfill the requirements for one degree may not be used to fulfill requirements for another degree. Therefore, courses you have taken to fulfill another degree, such as your master's courses, cannot be used to fulfill requirements in the Ed.S.
- Students are only able to be enrolled in one field experience, including those with grades of "IP" (practicum or internship) per semester. For example, if you are registered for SCON Internship I, you may NOT enroll in CMHC Practicum I. Or if you are completing an IP in CMHC Internship II, you are not able to enroll in SCON Practicum.

Consult the Graduate School Catalog and a CES advisor regarding prerequisites. By EHHS Policy all coursework counted toward a degree must be completed within 5 years of the first enrollment in courses(s) used to complete the Prospectus/Plan of Study. **The signing of this Prospectus also indicates that the student has thoroughly read the CES Master's Program Brochure and Student Handbook.**
