Proposal Summary

Large-Scale Revision to Cultural Foundation Courses

Description of Action, Including Intended Effect

This large-scale revision will change schedule type and prerequisites for all graduate Cultural Foundations [CULT] courses that are currently classified as Lecture (see list below) Schedule Types. Instead of "Lecture" all of these courses should be designated as "Seminar." In addition, "Special Approval" is being removed as prerequisites, from these same courses (where applicable). All other prerequisites will remain the same.

The "seminar" designation more accurately reflects the style of teaching and learning in our courses. Special approval has proved to be more of a hindrance than a help to enrollment, especially for students outside of our program area.
