## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Geauga Campus enrollment for the Summer III 13 Term. The Geauga Campus experienced a 13.90% decrease in student headcount; 576 students in Summer III 13 compared to 669 students in Summer III 12 for a net decrease of 93 students. Undergraduate enrollment decreased by 13.53% (-90 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by 75% (-3 students).

Student FTE decrease by 19.10%; the Geauga Campus generated 14.74 less FTE compared to Summer III 12. Undergraduate FTE decreased by 18.94% (-14.54 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 50% (-0.20 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 1.62 compared to 1.73 in Summer III 12. Graduate MUL is 3.00 compared to last year's 1.50 and the campus MUL is 1.63 compared to 1.73 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
