TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards are for Computer Information Systems majors. They are offered by the Center for Information Systems in the College of Business Administration and may be applied towards Kent State University tuition for the next semester. The selection process will be based on academic merit, leadership potential, and communication and IT skills. At the discretion of the CIS Scholarship Committee up to 5 awards are planned.

In addition to the above CIS Tuition Scholarships, Hyland Software is offering a \$1,000 tuition scholarship. Applying for this scholarship will give Hyland the opportunity to review your application and potentially consider you as a candidate for an internship or full time position.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNTS: \$500 to \$2,500

MAJOR: Computer Information Systems

CLASS STANDING: Minimum 3 hours completed in CIS courses including M&IS 24053 **or** currently enrolled in M&IS 24053 and earning an A or B

GPA REQUIREMENTS: Minimum 2.75 in CIS courses

OTHER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Full-time or part-time undergraduate student
Not graduating for at least one more semester
Preference will be given to MISA (The Management Information Systems Association) members and/or students with IT-related work experience

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS: The CIS Scholarship Committee reserves the right to select award recipients and award amounts however they deem appropriate
For an application to be considered, it must include a completed form and all supporting documentation
