## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent Campus enrollment for the Fall 12 Term. The Kent Campus experienced a 2.68% increase in student headcount; 28,602 students in Fall 12 compared to 27,855 students in Fall 11 for a net increase of 747 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 0.79% (176 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 10.21% (571 students).

Student FTE increase by 3.16%; the Kent Campus generated 729.40 more FTE compared to Fall 11. Undergraduate FTE increased by 0.20% (40.66 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 22.63% (688.73 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 13.42 compared to 13.50 in Fall 11. Graduate MUL is 9.08 compared to last year's 8.16 and the campus MUL is 12.48 compared to 12.42 last year.
