1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent Campus enrollment for the Summer I&II 12 Term. The Kent Campus experienced a 3.25% increase in student headcount; 8,760 students in Summer I&II 12 compared to 8,484 students in Summer I&II 11 for a net increase of 276 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 3.87% (211 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 2.15% (65 students).

Student FTE increase by 5.40%; the Kent Campus generated 79.14 more FTE compared to Summer I&II 11. Undergraduate FTE increased by 3.04% (27.04 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 9.05% (52.10 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 2.43 compared to 2.44 in Summer I&II 11. Graduate MUL is 3.05 compared to last year's 2.85 and the campus MUL is 2.64 compared to 2.59 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
