## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent Campus enrollment for the Summer III 11 Term. The Kent Campus experienced a 11.53% increase in student headcount; 4,498 students in Summer III 11 compared to 4,033 students in Summer III 10 for a net increase of 465 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 20.52% (512 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by 3.06% (-47 students).

Student FTE increase by 2.75%; the Kent Campus generated 15.67 more FTE compared to Summer III 10. Undergraduate FTE increased by 16.58% (52.47 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 14.48% (-36.80 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 1.84 compared to 1.90 in Summer III 10. Graduate MUL is 2.19 compared to last year's 2.48 and the campus MUL is 1.96 compared to 2.12 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
