

Connecting to FlashZone WPA
MAC OS X

NOTE: If you have Version 10.3 or below, your version of OS X is out-of-date and unsupported by Apple. You will need to purchase an upgrade to access the wireless system. To determine your version, click on the Apple Menu in the upper left-hand corner of the screen, and choose *About this Mac*. The window that pops up will have your version number.

1. Go to Kent State Stark home page www.stark.kent.edu and log into FlashLine. Logging into FlashLine will prompt you if you need to change your password.
2. Make sure that your AirPort Wireless Card is enabled. In the upper right corner of your desktop, click the wireless icon and make sure the AirPort is **ON**. If it is **OFF**, click the option **Turn AirPort On**.
3. Receive the wireless configuration utility off of a flashdrive from the East Wing Computer lab or Download the XpressConnect wireless configuration utility from <http://flashzone.kent.edu/> or stop at the Library or the East Wing Computer lab.
4. Save the file (**flashzone.dmg**) to your desktop.
5. Double-click **flashzone.dmg** on your desktop to launch the utility.
6. The installer will launch and extract its contents. Double-click the FlashZone icon to launch the configuration utility.
7. Click **Trust** in the window to accept the signed certificate.
8. Enter your Flashline username and password. Click **Continue**
Note: Your username does not require "@kent.edu" to be appended to it.
9. Enter your Username and password for your Mac's Administrative Account. Click **OK**
Note: This is NOT your Flashline username and password.
10. Next, you will be asked whether or not you will allow the credentials to be used from your Mac's keychain. Click **Allow**.
11. You should see the window acknowledge that it has successfully configured and associated with FlashZone-WPA.
12. If you have successfully authenticated to the network, your web browser should start.
