## TRANSCRIPT LEGEND

### Accreditation

Bowling Green State University is accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools as a degree-granting institution at the associate, baccalaureate, master, and doctoral levels. In addition to this comprehensive accreditation, curricula in some of the colleges and departments are individually accredited by their respective associations. The University is accredited by the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE).

### Calendar

Beginning in Fall Term 1982, Bowling Green State University began operating under an early semester calendar. In addition, there is a summer session consisting of different-length terms. From September, 1968, until August, 1982, the University operated under the quarter system. Prior to September, 1968, the semester calendar was in effect at the institution. All enrollment and statistical hours are expressed in semester units.

### Course Numbering System

Non-degree credit courses are numbered 1-99; elementary courses are 100-199 or 1000-1999; sophomore courses are 200-299 or 2000-2999; junior and senior level courses are 300-499 or 3000-4999; and graduate courses are 500-800 or 5000-8000. A senior may take 500 (5000) and 600 (6000) level courses for graduate credit with permission of the Graduate College. Courses at the 700 (7000) level or above are exclusively for graduate students.

### Academic Forgiveness

A student who returns to BGSU after an extended absence, who meets the conditions of the policy, may use it to remove the effect of earlier unsatisfactory grades. The grade point average is calculated from the point of readmission without losing credit for all previous course work with a grade of S, C or better. Grades that have been forgiven are noted as being under the Academic Forgiveness grading basis.

### Transfer Credit

In the case of transfer credit, each record is reviewed and evaluated individually. A transfer student's accumulative grade point average reflects only those grades received in courses taken at BGSU.

### S/U Grading Policy

For undergraduate courses, the grade of S is interpreted as falling within the range of A to C and carries full credit. A grade of U is interpreted as D through F and carries no credit. For graduate courses, the grade of S is interpreted as falling within the range of A and B and carries full credit. A grade of U is interpreted as C through F and carries no credit.
