JACKSON TOWNSHIP POLICE ON CAMPUS

Campus Security works closely with the Jackson Township Police Department and officers patrol campus regularly. Officers patrol parking lots, campus grounds and inside buildings.

SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS

Campus Security uses surveillance cameras in parking lots and select areas of buildings.

CAMPUS DAILY CRIME LOG

While incidents of crime are rare, Campus Security maintains a log of all criminal activity that occurs on campus to remain compliant with the Clery Act.

You can view or obtain a copy of the Campus Daily Crime Log from the Security Desk in the Campus Center or the Public Safety Manager's office in 117A Main Hall.

LOST AND FOUND

Found something? Drop it off at the Campus Security Desk in the Campus Center or call us and we will pick it up from you and take it to the Business Office for safe keeping.

Lost something? Check in the Business Office in 128 Main Hall. At the end of each semester, all unclaimed items will be donated to Interfaith Campus Ministry or discarded as appropriate. Textbooks will be turned over to the bookstore.

WHEN TO CALL CAMPUS SECURITY

Call Campus Security at **330-244-3333** in the event of:

- » Suspicious persons or activities
- » Automobile accidents
- » Illness or Injuries
- » Security escort requests to your car or campus buildings
- » Jump start your car
- » Unlock your car as long as your car is registered with Campus Security
- » Anytime you need assistance

SAFETY TIPS

- » Make note of Emergency Phone locations in parking lots and buildings.
- » Know your tornado shelters and fire exit locations for each classroom.
- » Upon a fire evacuation, move far away from the building to make room for first responders.
- » When walking, pay attention to people and traffic.
- » Smartphone use while walking causes trips, falls and walks into walls.
- » Don't leave your belongings unattended! Use the hooks in the restroom stalls to hang your items out of reach.
- » Utilize Campus Security for escorts to your car or buildings, or walk with a buddy.

PARKING

DRIVING ON CAMPUS

- » A general 15-mph speed limit is in effect for the campus parking areas. A 25-mph speed limit is in effect for all campus roadways.
- » Drivers must yield to pedestrians at all times.
- » Anyone operating a vehicle recklessly on campus without regard for the safety of others will be subject to disciplinary action or law enforcement referral.

GENERAL PARKING INFORMATION

Kent State University at Stark provides free parking for students, faculty/staff and visitors. Each lot is designated with signage to indicate parking for students, faculty/staff or visitors.

You must register vehicles that you regularly drive to campus with Campus Security. Vehicle registration and issuing of parking hang tags takes place before classes begin. Visit www.kent.edu/stark/parking-services for vehicle registration procedures. Parking hang tags are good for the fall and spring semesters. Hang tags are **not** required for summer terms.

Adequate parking is provided on campus, but does not guarantee a parking space immediately adjacent to the building in which a student has class.

All drivers, except campus visitors, are required to display their parking hang tag from the rearview mirror with the ID number facing outward.

Multiple parking offenses may result in a referral to the Office of Student Conduct and possible revocation of parking privileges on the Stark Campus.

KENT CAMPUS PARKING INFORMATION:

Stark Campus parking hang tags are **not** valid for parking at the Kent Campus. If you have a valid Kent Campus parking hang tag, you do not have to register your vehicle or obtain a hang tag at the Stark Campus.

PARKING RULES & RESTRICTIONS

Violation notices will be issued to vehicles parked improperly. Violations include but are not limited to:

- » Failure to register your vehicle with Campus Security.
- » Failure to display parking hang tag.
- » Parking in a disability space without a visible and up to date BMV issued placard or plate (additionally subject to law enforcement).
- » Utilizing more than one parking space or parking outside the designated lines.
- » Parking in a designated faculty/staff parking area. Your vehicle may be subject to a boot.
- » Parking in a location other than a designated parking space.
- » Parking an oversized or recreational vehicle, boat or trailer on campus without prior authorization from the Public Safety Manager.
- » Overnight/weekend parking is allowed if traveling with university purpose, mechanical issues or other special circumstances. Such parking arrangements need to be requested through the Public Safety Manager.
- » Parking on playing fields, grass areas or on curb sides.
- » Parking in such a manner that other vehicle owners cannot access or move their vehicle.
- » Motorcycles must be parked in the designated concrete pads in Lots 101 and 107, or on any asphalt parking space with the use of a kickstand disk.
- » Bicycles must be parked and secured in designated racks. Unsecured bicycles will be locked to the rack by Campus Security and you must call to have it unlocked.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Clearly marked accessible parking spaces have been established in Lots 101, 103, 105, 106, 107 and 201.

- » A state issued disability parking placard or license plate is required and must be displayed.
- » You may only use a disability parking placard issued from the state in your name. You cannot use a family member's placard to obtain close parking.
- » **Misuse of a disability parking placard or license plate is a crime.**
- » Your personal physician or health care provider can help you obtain a disability parking placard.
- » Suspected violations are referred to the Jackson Township Police Department for investigation and possible placard citation or revocation.

PARKING LOT EMERGENCY PHONES

Parking lots are equipped with campus phones for your safety. If you have an emergency and need immediate assistance, press the 911 button to be connected to the Jackson Township Police Department.

Campus Security can be contacted by calling 53333 from these phones. The phones can also be used to contact anyone on campus using their campus extension. These phones are not capable of calling off-campus phone numbers.

Emergency phones are located in Lots 101, 104, 105, 106, 107, 201 and the Pond & Wetlands Research Area.
