



Studying Abroad This Summer?

Important Summer Financial Aid Information

1. If you'd like to use federal direct loans, complete the **Financial Aid Enrollment Plan Questions** in Flashline. If you have any questions or need to update your enrollment plans, please refer to the Financial Aid Summer Information Page at <http://www.kent.edu/financialaid/summer>.
2. By indicating summer enrollment on your **Enrollment Plan**, your federal loan(s) can be split evenly three ways throughout the academic year: summer, fall, and spring. To receive additional summer loan money, you can look into the Parent PLUS Loan at <https://www.kent.edu/financialaid/federal-direct-parent-plus-loan> or private loans at <https://www.kent.edu/financialaid/private-loans>.
3. If you meet the **eligibility requirements** for the Federal Pell Grant or Ohio College Opportunity Grant, you will be awarded an amount of aid for the summer based on your enrollment status.
4. Be aware that there are **no payment plans** in the summer semester, and all charges are due on the payment due date found at <https://www.kent.edu/bursar/summer-due-dates>.
5. If you graduate in the summer or fall, your Direct Loan amount will be **prorated** based on your final term enrollment.
6. If attending the **New York City Studio**, you must fill out the **NYC Housing Addendum form** if you want to request additional financial aid found on <https://www.kent.edu/financialaid/forms>.
7. If you need to request additional room in your budget for financial aid due to increased costs from study abroad expenses, you can fill out the **Education Abroad Cost of Attendance Increase form** found on <https://www.kent.edu/financialaid/forms>.
8. For all **Exchange/Direct Enroll and ISEP programs**, you will need to fill out the Transfer Course Planning Form with your academic advisor found on <https://www.kent.edu/financialaid/forms>. Students attending the **Florence Institute, NYC Studio, or Short-Term Faculty-Led Programs** do not need to fill out the Transfer Course Planning Form.
9. If your program starts in **Intersession**, be aware that summer financial aid does not disburse until 10 days before the Summer I courses start at Kent State in June – even if your study abroad program starts before this date. You can pay for your program out of pocket and use your student refund to pay yourself back once refunded. Find more information here at <http://www.kent.edu/financialaid/summer>.
