1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Trumbull Campus enrollment for the Summer I&II 10 Term. The Trumbull Campus experienced a 26.21% increase in student headcount; 1,040 students in Summer I&II 10 compared to 824 students in Summer I&II 09 for a net increase of 216 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 25.79% (212 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 200.00% (4 students).

Student FTE increased by 27.54%; the Trumbull Campus generated 30.27 more FTE compared to Summer I&II 09. Undergraduate FTE increased by 27.21% (29.80 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 117.50% (.47 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 4.04 compared to 4.00 in Summer I&II 09. Graduate MUL is 4.33 compared to last year's 6.00 and the campus MUL is 4.04 compared to 4.00 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
