^{**}A historical grade of "F" reflects the repeat course policy which was in effect from February, 1992 through March 1995 allowing a student to repeat a course for which a grade of C-, D+, D, or D- was received. Only the higher of the two grades was used to calculate the cumulative GPA. The repeat course policy which was in effect from March, 1995 through July 2013 allows any student who has not graduated to retake a course for which any grade of C- or below was received (including "F"). The highest grade is used to calculate the cumulative GPA. Effective July, 2013, if the first attempt of a repeated course is taken within the first 0-29 semester credit hours enrolled only the higher grade of the two attempts will be used to calculate the cumulative grade point average. Otherwise both grades calculate in the cumulative GPA.
