

LETTER-SIZE MAIL DIMENSIONAL STANDARDS TEMPLATE



USE THIS TEMPLATE TO CHECK FOR MINIMUM SIZE,
PROPER HEIGHT TO LENGTH RATIO AND THICKNESS.

STANDARD SIZES (Only for First-Class Mail weighing one ounce or less):
THE TIP OF THE UPPER RIGHT CORNER OF THE MAILPIECE MUST TOUCH THIS SHADED AREA TO BE MAILED AT REGULAR POSTAGE.
A SURCHARGE WILL BE ADDED TO NON-STANDARD SIZE MAIL.

MAXIMUM POSTCARD DIMENSIONS - 4 1/4" BY 6"

MINIMUM

3 1/2" by 5" and at least .007 inches thick

To be mailable, piece edges must touch or extend beyond dotted lines.

Pieces .25 inch thick or less not meeting any one of these requirements are **NONMAILABLE**. (Pieces such as keys and identification devices are not subject to the minimum standards except for the thickness requirement.)

TO USE TEMPLATE, PLACE LOWER LEFT CORNER OF PIECE HERE.

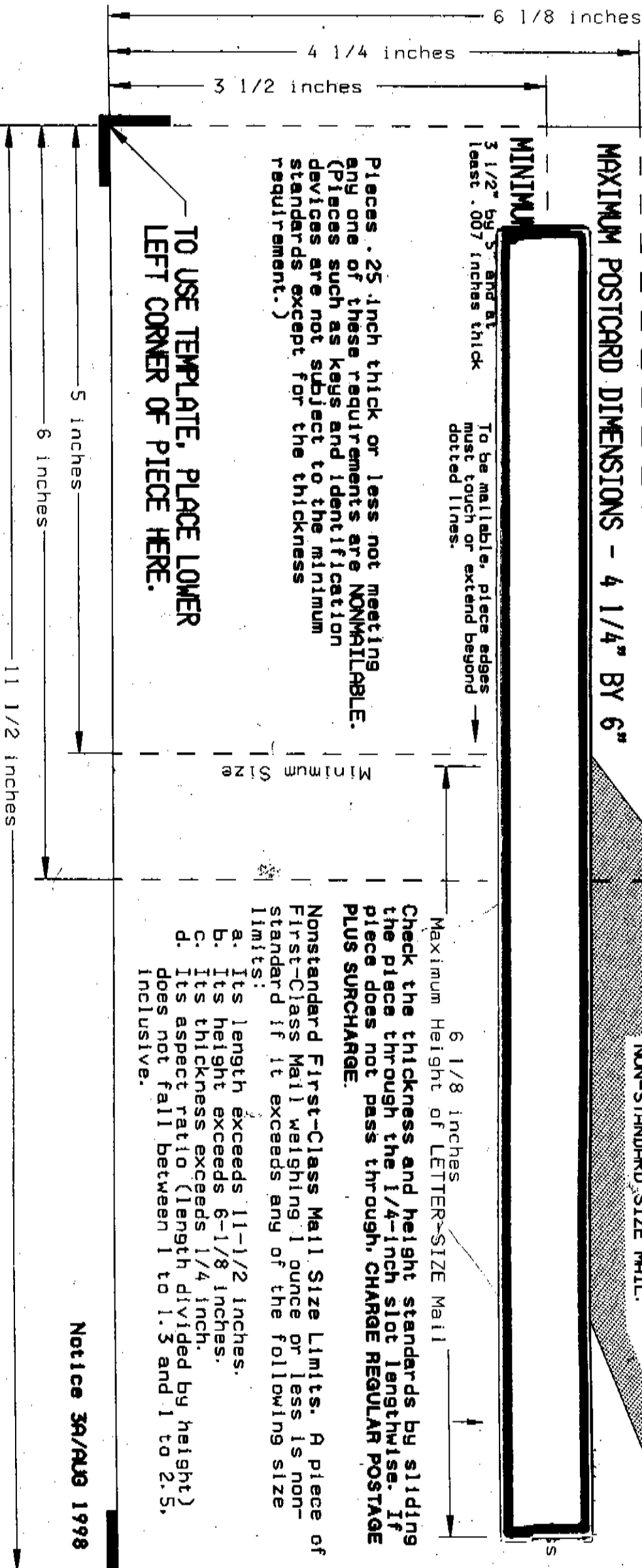

Maximum Height of LETTER-SIZE Mail

Check the thickness and height standards by sliding the piece through the 1/4-inch slot lengthwise. If piece does not pass through, **CHARGE REGULAR POSTAGE PLUS SURCHARGE.**

Nonstandard First-Class Mail Size Limits. A piece of First-Class Mail weighing 1 ounce or less is non-standard if it exceeds any of the following size limits:

- Its length exceeds 11-1/2 inches.
- Its height exceeds 6-1/8 inches.
- Its thickness exceeds 1/4 inch.
- Its aspect ratio (length divided by height) does not fall between 1 to 1.3 and 1 to 2.5, inclusive.
