FIRST-TIME COLLEGE APPLICANTS (OVER AGE 21):

- If you have not attended any educational institution since graduating from high school or obtaining your GED, complete the freshman admissions application at www.kent.edu/admissions/apply.
- Request an official copy of your high school transcript or GED score report be sent directly to the Admissions Office, Kent State University, P.O. Box 5190, Kent, OH 44242-0001.
- Once admitted, you will receive information on academic advising and course registration options.

TRANSFER APPLICANTS:

- If you have attended any educational institution after graduating from high school or obtaining your GED, complete the transfer admissions application online at www.kent.edu/admissions. Early application helps ensure early consideration for class registration, residence hall preference and financial aid. Therefore, the best time to apply is at least six months prior to the term you wish to enter.
- Request official transcripts from all institutions attended since high school be sent directly to the Admissions Office, Kent State University, P.O. Box 5190, Kent, OH 44242-0001.
 - Transfer students with fewer than 12 semester hours or 18 quarter hours at the college level should also submit an official high school transcript or GED score report.
 - Students with military credit should request an AARTS/SMARTS transcript at www.military.com.

- In general, a transfer applicant who has taken more than 12 semester hours with a cumulative grade average of at least a 2.0 as computed by Kent State University (on a 4.0 scale) may be admitted. An applicant who has taken fewer than 12 semester hours will be evaluated on both collegiate and high school records. (high school transcript and ACT or SAT score)
- Once admitted, sign up for a Transfer Kent State: Orientation, Advising and Registration program or contact the appropriate advising office after receiving your transfer credit evaluation to discuss your evaluation, degree requirements and selection of courses.
