**PEP 15015: Fundamental Movement, Gymnastics and Dance** (3 credits): This course is designed to provide teachers and activity leaders with knowledge, skills, and dispositions necessary to teach developmentally appropriate progressions for fundamental movement skills, dance and gymnastics. Emphasis is placed on movement development and analysis through practice in fundamental locomotor and manipulative movements, gymnastics and dance.

**PEP 15015: Development and Analysis of Net Games** (3 credits): This course is designed for PE majors to develop content knowledge for teaching net/wall games to secondary grades. (i.e., lecture, peer teaching, and performance analysis on campus).

**PEP 25025: Teaching in Physical Education** (3 credits): This course is designed for PE majors to develop knowledge and skills related to PE pedagogy. (1.5hr lecture, 1hr teaching performance laps, and 0.5hr field observations).

**PEP 25033: Life Span Motor Development** (3 credits): This course is designed for diverse major students in EHHS to understand and apply fundamental concepts regarding motor development throughout the life span. This course has been organized as a 100% online course since the summer of 2015.

**PEP 45053/CI 55053 Elementary School Physical Education Content** (3 credits): This course is designed for PE majors to develop knowledge and skills related to teaching PE to elementary grades. (2.5hr lecture and peer teaching on campus for 10 weeks and 0.5hr field teaching for 5 weeks).

**PEP 49525: Inquiry into Professional Practice in Physical Education** (3 credits): This course is designed for student teachers in physical education to reflect on their field teaching experiences and make necessary changes to their practice based on those reflections. Furthermore, throughout the course, student teachers will engage in a Teacher Performance Assessment (edTPA) to demonstrate their knowledge, understanding and application of planning, instruction, and assessment that demonstrates student learning.

ELS 65035: Contemporary Issues in Sport Pedagogy (3 credits): This course is a 100% web-based course designed for understanding the contemporary issues being faced in sport pedagogy at the graduate level.

CI 65055: Curriculum Development in Physical Education (3 credits): This course is designed for PE major master's students to develop knowledge and skills for developing effective curriculum in physical education (100% online course).

**KIN 477 Physical Education Curriculums** (3 credits): This course is designed for about 35 PE majors to engage in the design of Web Quest program for enhancing student learning, the grant writing project for promoting PE curriculums, and the design of PE curriculums for the elementary, middle, and high schools.

**EDU PAES 143.01 Badminton 1** (2 credits): This course is designed to develop fundamental techniques and tactics needed to play badminton plays.

**EDU PAES 157.01 Golf 1** (2 credits): This course is designed to learn basic steps for golf swing and fundamental rules for playing golf games.
